Condition **Difficult in places, passable with caution**

Description of the walk

Starting from the Metochi - Lafkos road (by the large map signpost)

Condition of the walk

Photo 6 relates to the section of path just beyond the track leading to the solar farm (the one to the west of the road). This is a narrow little path that is starting to become overgrown. Approximately 750 m along this section of path, the path seems to come to a halt (just beyond a stoned section over a stream). It was not clear to the walker, whether this was the finish of the path is as a result of being overgrown or a minor landslide. It will be re-checked.

Photo 7, 8, and 9 relates to the final section of the path leading to Lafkos. (The other sections were all passable and in reasonable condition apart from a few loose stones and coverings of mud washed down on to the tracks).

Photo 7 shows a section of the track (approximately 200 or 300m along this section), washed away. The track is still passable but does pose a safety risk.

Photo 8 shows part of the track that has been washed away. It is still passable.

Photo 9 shows a blocked section of the track as a result of a landslide. It is approximately 750m along the track. It was possible to get past this blockage by climbing up the hillside and pushing through tree branches and undergrowth. It is not recommended.
